Welcome Back

ENGLISH



We will be starting the term with a whole school topic around Fairy tales. In particular, we will be exploring the Grimm's Fairy Tale: The Singing Bone. Focusing on the character of the older brother, we will be building a 1st person narrative, concentrating on effective cohesion and accurate sentence structures.

MATHS



During the first half term, we will ensure that the children have a secure understanding of place value, as well as starting to work within the four operations. This will include solving problems with multiple steps and ensuring their fluency with number bonds and times tables are able to be recalled in context.

SCIENCE



Our first topic is 'light'. We will be looking closely at how we see light and how light travels. The children will be investigating whether light can travel through corners and be introduced to the concepts of reflection and refraction.

HISTORY



In history this term, the children will study what life looked like in ancient Greece. We will be exploring key achievements within that time period and their influences on the western world. We will be learning about the culture and society that they had through looking at their philosophy, religious views, and democracy.

PSHE

In PSHE, will be exploring how to keep ourselves healthy as we grow. We will be looking at becoming more independent and responsible through making healthy choices about exercise, food, sleep, hygiene and our safety.
