ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will be continuing to focus on the structure of our sentences, using the conjunction and to join our ideas together. We will be exploring this by beginning our term off with the book "How to look after your dinosaur". The children will be retelling the story and then writing sentences to inform others of how they can look after a real-life dinosaur".

MATHS



In maths this half term, we will be moving on from looking at numbers to 10 and expanding our understanding of numbers beyond 10.

We will be focusing on being fluent with number bonds and using resources to identify different parts to make a whole number.

History



In history this term, we are going to be looking at the life of a significant individual who has contributed to national and international achievement. To explore this in detail, we will be learning about Grace Darling and how she had an incredible role in rescuing people from a shipwreck. We will be discovering how this has had an impact on rescue services today.

Art
