ENGLISH

To start this term, we will be exploring the character of Lady Macbeth and practicing our persuasive devices. We will then use the novel 'Goldfish Boy' for our reading and to inspire our creative writing.



MATHS



In maths this half term, we will be starting to learn about decimals and percentages. We will learn to convert between fractions, decimals and percentages and begin to see the connections between them. We will end the term by finding the area and perimeter of polygons, including compound shapes.

GEOGRAPHY
