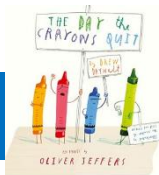

ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will first read 'The day the crayons quit' and focus on the use of conjunctions and questions. We will write a letter imitating the authors voice as one of the crayons. Then, we will retell the life of a crayon. We will also practice, and continue to develop, our oracy skills with some performance poetry.



MATHS

This half term, we will continue our learning about multiplication and division. Then, we will start our money topic. We will be looking at counting and comparing amounts and making change. Towards the end of term, we will start length and measurement, in which we will think about centimetres and metres, and comparing and ordering lengths.

Geography

In geography, we are going to be carrying out a comparison of London and Cairo. We will look at their physical and human features as well as their climate and landmarks.



History

In history, will continue our study of Eltham Palace and its place in our local community. We will explore how the heritage site has been used over the past millennia.
