ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will be continuing the spy adventure – Stormbreaker by Anthony Horowitz and writing our very own spy adventure chapter for the book. Next, we will be developing our knowledge of writing in the present progressive tense. We will be writing a first-person emotive narrative around taking a penalty.



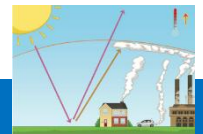
MATHS

In maths, the children will continue to prepare for their SATs through arithmetic and reasoning practice. They will also continue to develop their understanding of shape, exploring 3-D nets and angles in quadrilaterals and polygons. Additionally, we will be building on our knowledge of decimals, percentages and fractions.



SCIENCE

This half term we will be exploring the world of living things and their habitats with a focus on classification of animals, plants and micro-organisms. We will be looking at how scientists use observable features of plants, animals and micro-organisms to group, classify and identify them into broad groups, using keys and other methods.



Geography

In this half term, we are exploring how 'The Great Pacific Garbage Patch' was formed and what humans are doing to help prevent it. The children will learn about the causes and effects of climate change and how this impacts the world's oceans.

PHSE

The key question that we are learning about in PSHE is 'What will change as we become more independent?' We will be discussing different types of relationships, changing and growing, adulthood and independence as we transition to secondary school.
