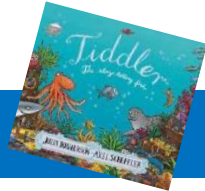

LITERACY

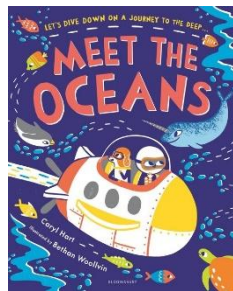


In Literacy we will be reading texts which relate to the topic of Under the Sea: 'Tiddler' by Julia Donaldson, 'Commotion in the Ocean' by Giles Andreae and various non-fiction books. Using these texts, we will be writing our own facts, clues and stories. We will continue with daily phonics and will consolidate our learnt graphemes but within longer words as part of Little Wandle Phase 4. We will continue to read and write sentences independently.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will use the topic of 'Under the Sea' to learn about the oceans and continents. We will compare the different environments and discuss the habitats.

This will be consolidated on our trip to the Horniman Museum.



PSHE

We will continue to teach the Horn Park values across the term both in class and in our weekly assemblies. Our values are: respect, positivity, unity, honesty, kindness and perseverance.

We will also support children with a gradual transition to year 1. In addition to our daily handwriting sessions, we will also start to complete some learning in the year 1 classroom.

MATHS

Throughout the summer term, we will be working on numbers to 20 and their composition. This will include place value and seeing amounts in tens and ones. Alongside learning the 'teen' numbers, we will be consolidating number bonds to 10, adding and subtracting, doubles and odds and evens.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

In PE we will be learning various team games in preparation for Sports Day.

As we move into the warmer months, we will start to complete PE sessions outside and will practice playing on the large playground to support transition.

To support your child's understanding and learning, here are some simple ideas for you to try at home that link to our key targets and topics. Over the next half term, could you...

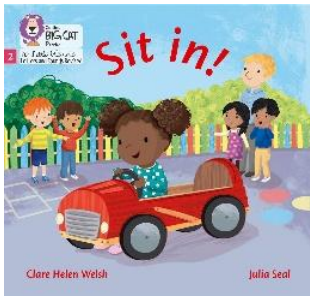
Watch number blocks at home and look out for numbers 11-20.
