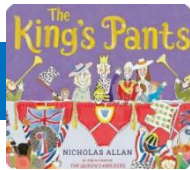




Welcome Back

ENGLISH



In English, we will be focusing on the book, "The King's Pants" by Nicholas Allan. We will begin the sequence by writing a retell of the original story to familiarise ourselves with the story and the new vocabulary. We will then write a character description of the king. Using all our new vocabulary that we have learnt throughout the book, we will then be innovating the story to create our own way of how and where our character might lose their pants!

SCIENCE



In science this half term, we will be continuing to learn about plants and will be extending our learning based on our trip in the previous term to the flower garden in Greenwich. This will support us in examining different types of flowers and plants in order to recognise if they are common or wild plants and to be able to discuss the differences between the two.

History



In history this term, we are focusing on ships and boats and how they have developed over time. We will compare the similarities of ships from the past to the present. Whilst doing this, we will explore if their purpose has changed.

MATHS



In maths this term, we will be learning about place value from the number 50 to 100. We will explore partitioning the numbers into tens and ones to gain a deeper understanding of each number and their value. Later in the term, we will begin to look at time. We will investigate half past and to the hour.

RE

In RE this term, we will be continuing to learn about the Jewish faith, specifically looking at the festivals they celebrate and the reasoning behind them. We will be exploring how through these celebrations they teach young Jewish people about the past.
