



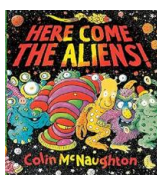
Welcome back!

This half-term in Literacy, we will be exploring the theme of 'Space' through a range of mediums, including books, animation and sensory stories.



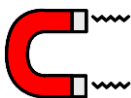
MATHS
