Year 3 are very proud to announce that they are all winners of The Young Writer's competition 'Poetry Towers' and will be having their storm poems published in a book.



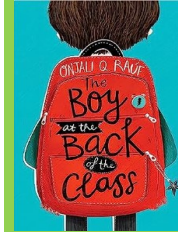
