




We hope that everybody had a lovely summer. We are thrilled to see the children return to school well-rested and eager for the year to come.

ENGLISH



We will be starting the term with a whole school topic around William Shakespeare's 'The Tempest'. Focusing on the character of Caliban, we will be writing a 1st person narrative and character description using expanded noun phrases and focusing on correct sentence structure.

SCIENCE



We will be studying electricity. We will experiment with building our own circuits to understand the component parts. Then, we will make our own switches to investigate how it impacts on the circuit. Finally, we will explore different materials to discover whether they are electrical conductors or insulators.

RE



We will be studying Hinduism this term, starting with exploring Hindu life. We will discuss the beliefs Hindus have about creation and explore some key facts about the religion including the ways in which they worship. Finally, we will consider how their beliefs impact Hindu life and the choices they make.

MATHS



We will explore 3- and 4-digit numbers and how they are represented and manipulated. After, we will begin addition and subtraction topics; we will review learning from Year 3, before applying our skills to larger numbers. Throughout the year, we will be learning all our times tables ahead of the Multiplication Checker in June – practice at home will help us achieve excellent scores!

HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY



In History, we will be learning about the Romans. We will explore reasons for invasion of Britain and their overall success, as well as the diversity in Roman Britain, including Emperor Septimius Severus. In Geography, we will be starting our whole-year Antarctica and Arctic topic, exploring the geographical locations and climates of the Polar Regions.
