This half-term our topic is 'Night and Day' which we will link to our learning across the whole curriculum. We will focus on the changing seasons, weather, and natural world around us. ### **LITERACY**



This half term in Literacy, we will be looking at poetry and non – fiction texts alongside our core books: Owl Babies and Night Monkey, Day Monkey.

We will also be progressing with our daily phonics teaching. This half term we will move our focus on to identifying phase two phonemes, blending and initial sounds.

# UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will use our topic of Night and Day to look at the seasonal changes that come with Autumn. We will explore our local surroundings and learn about nocturnal and diurnal animals.

We will be linking this to road safety and the dark, discussing how we can keep ourselves and others safe.

# Personal, Social Development

Horn Park follows a 'values-based education'. Throughout the half term we will spend time embedding these within our setting. Our school values are: respect, positivity, unity, honesty, perseverance and kindness.

During our circle time sessions we will be discussing the things that we like and how these may be different to others, but that this is okay.

#### **MATHS**

Within our maths sessions we will continue to consolidate our understanding of numbers to 5. We will then begin to compare amounts and use manipulatives such as five frames to encourage subitising.

We will continue to describe, create and compare patterns.

# PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

This half term we will continue to build our fine motor skills in order to strengthen our pincer grip for writing. This involves activities such as playdough, tweezers and using scissors.

Alongside this, we will build on the children's independence with tasks such as doing up zips and preparing food in cooking sessions.
