ENGLISH

This half-term in literacy, Millennium will use our class story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' as a vehicle to continue to develop language, comprehension, reading and writing skills through a range of hands-on activities. We will be going on a trip to Oxleas woods and we will be creating our very own 'Bear Hunt'. Sycamores will be learning about transport this term. We will be reading 'The Naughty Bus' and 'Journey' where we will make our very own 'Sycamore Journey Book'.

MATHS



Millennium this term will continue to build on the children's individual understanding of core concepts such as numbers, shapes, addition and subtraction. We will be exploring reading and writing numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. In Sycamores we will be looking at patterns and deepening our number knowledge.

SCIENCE

In science this term, Millennium will be developing a better understanding of the human body. We will be looking at the main human body parts, including the head, neck, arms and mouth as well as their functions. We will be focusing on the importance of exercising the body and eating the right amount of food to stay healthy. We will also develop a better understanding of self-care and developing the importance of hygiene.



GEOGRAPHY



Our focus this term will be to develop our map reading skills. We will use simplified maps to name and locate different continents and find out key facts about these places. The children will have the opportunity to create posters and postcards to send to their family to try and entice them to visit.
