ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will continue to work on developing our sentences. We will begin by writing the next adventure the 'Tear Thief' might go on, trying to imitate the author's structure. Then, we will read 'Traction Man is Here' and focus on the use of present tense to create excitement for our reader. Finally, we will write letters as one of the crayons from 'The Day the Crayons quit'.

MATHS



This half term, in Maths, we will begin by continuing our multiplication and division topic, looking closely at the 2, 5 and 10-times table. After that, we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. Towards the end of the term we will start our money topic. We will be looking at counting amounts, comparing amounts and making change.

Geography

In geography, we are going to be carrying out a comparison of London and Cairo. We will look at their physical and human features as well as their climate and landmarks.



Design and Technology

In DT, we are going to be designing and creating a structure for local wildlife in our urban environment. This will link to our Forest School learning.

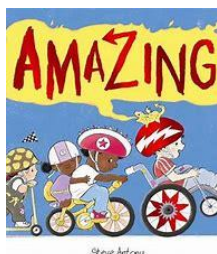
Trips
