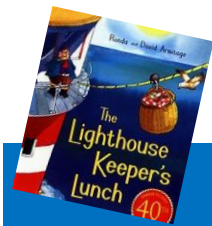

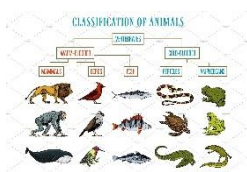
### Welcome Back

#### ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will be continuing to focus on the structure of our sentences, using conjunctions and will begin to use the 'un' prefix to words to show deeper understanding of vocabulary and how it can change the meaning of a word. We will be starting spring 2 off with the book 'The lighthouse keeper's lunch.' During this time the children will have the opportunity to come up with a sneaky plan to stop the seagulls from stealing the lighthouse keeper's lunch.

#### Science

During this term in science, we will be continuing with our topic of animals. We have previously discussed "if humans are classified animals." We will now begin to look at the different animal groups and why animals are classified in certain way.



#### RE

This term in RE, we will be continuing to learn and become familiarised with the teachings of Christianity. We will be looking specifically about the importance of Easter and the reasons behind why Christians celebrate during this time.

#### MATHS

In maths this half term we will be moving on from place value within 20 to now exploring greater numbers to 50. We will be consolidating our learning of this in small steps; children will count forwards and backwards between 20 and 50. We will continue to identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line.



#### DT

In DT we will start of our topic of rescue boats. This will run alongside our history topic of Grace Darling. We will be investigating which materials may be appropriate to use and why. We will then explore different way we could connect different parts of the boat for our rescue boat to be sustainable and stable.
