



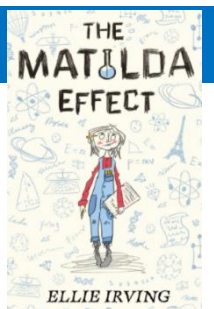
Welcome Back

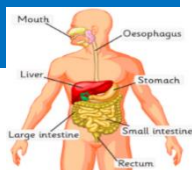
ENGLISH

In English this half term, we will be focusing on the text "The Matilda Effect" by Ellie Erving. We will be writing letters in role and developing our grammatical skills, including sentence structure. We will also be creating fact files about female scientists we should all know.



SCIENCE

In science this half term, we will be exploring the functions of the different parts of the digestive system, as well as exploring how it works. We will be taking a close look at the different types of teeth and tooth decay.



RE

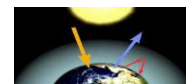
ART
