ENGLISH

In English this half term, we are developing our knowledge of writing in the present progressive tense. We will be writing a non-fiction factual documentary, in the style of David Attenborough, incorporating key knowledge and scientific vocabulary about an animal in its natural habitat. Additionally, the children will be writing a persuasive text about the role of zoos.



MATHS

In Maths, the children will continue to prepare for their SATs through arithmetic and reasoning practice. They will also develop a deep conceptual understanding of measurement through exploring area and perimeter of a variety of shapes. Additionally, we will be looking at statistics where we will be analysing pie charts, line graphs and calculating the mean, median, mode and average.

SCIENCE



This half term our Science topic is evolution and adaptation. As part of this, we will explore what the evidence is for evolution and using the basic ideas of inheritance, variation and adaptation to describe how living things have changed over time and evolved.

Geography

In this half term, we are exploring how 'The Great Pacific Garbage Patch' was formed and what humans are doing to help prevent it. The children will learn about the causes and effects of climate change and how this impacts the world's oceans.

PHSE

The key question that we are learning about in PSHE is 'What will change as we become more independent?' We will be discussing different types of relationships, changing and growing, adulthood and independence as we transition to secondary school.
